History of the Holy Cross where the Savior of the World was crucified: Jesus Christ

When the Body of Jesus was removed from the Cross, to prevent His followers from finding it, the Cross was thrown in a ditch or well, and then covered with stones and earth.



In Hoc Signo Vincas

In the year 312 A.D., almost 300 years later, while Constantine, who had not yet converted to Christianity, was in combat with Maxentius for the throne of the Roman Empire, he prayed to the Lord God of the Christians to help him in his battle. In answer to his prayer, a sign appeared in the sky. A luminous cross was seen with the words "BY THIS SIGN YOU WILL CONQUER" (in Latin, "IN HOC SIGNO VINCES") inscribed on it.

Constantine won the battle over Maxentius. Indebted to God for his victory at the Milvian Bridge on October 28, 312, Constantine commanded that the Sign of Christianity be placed on the Roman standards and on the shields of all the soldiers.

Then, on September 14, 326, Emperor Constantine's mother, **St. Helena**, found in **Jerusalem the True Cross on which Jesus was crucified**. The legend of the story of the discovery of the True Cross is that when visiting the holy places in Palestine, St. Helena was guided to the site of the Crucifixion by an aged Jew who had inherited traditional knowledge as to its location. After the ground had been dug to a considerable depth, three crosses were found, as well as the superscription placed over the Savior's head on the Cross, and the nails with which He had been crucified. The Cross of the Lord was distinguished from the other two by laying the crosses on a dead youth who was revived by the touch of the third Cross.



To commemorate the finding of the Holy Cross, Constantine dedicated two Churches upon Calvary, "Anastasis" and "Golgotha," both within the precincts of the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Beginning in those days, the **Feast of the "Exaltation of the Holy Cross" was commemorated annually on May 3**.

In 614, Chosroes II, the King of Persia, invaded Syria and Palestine, at which time he carried away many of the great treasures of Jerusalem, including the relic of the True Cross. In 629, Emperor Heraclius of Constantinople marched into Persia and recaptured the True Cross, seeing to it that Heraclius piously bring it back to Jerusalem while being clothed in sackcloth of penance and barefoot. **On September 14, the Sacred Cross was restored to its place in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem.**

To commemorate this victory, in the seventh century A.D., the Church of Rome adopted the **"Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross" on September 14.**

Today one may visit the Basilica Church of Santa Croce in Jerusalem (The Holy Cross in Jerusalem), located in Rome, in which a sizable portion of the Holy Cross is enshrined along with numerous other associated relics of the Passion, including a large portion of the sign that had been placed on the Cross saying "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews". It is from this church that the relic in our Shrine of the True Cross was obtained.

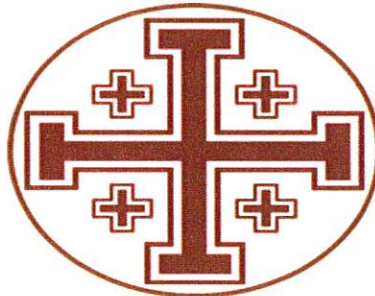

In 2010, the construction of the current temple was completed, and on September 19 of the same year the dedication was made on the occasion of the celebration of the 50th anniversary of the parish, a ceremony presided over by Bishop Gerald M. Barbarito; being the priest the reverend Néstor Rodríguez.

10 years later, September 13, 2020, Pastor Reverend Francisco Javier Osorio commemorates the 62nd anniversary of the spiritual life of the Parish of the Holy Cross, in Indiantown, Florida. Long live Christ the King!



Historia de La Sagrada Cruz en donde se crucifico al Salvador del Mundo: Jesucristo

Cuando el Cuerpo de Jesús fue retirado de la Cruz, para evitar que Sus seguidores lo encontraran, la Cruz fue arrojada en una zanja o en un pozo, y luego cubierta de piedras y tierra. En el año 312 d.C., casi 300 años más tarde, mientras que Constantino, que aún no se había convertido al cristianismo, estaba en combate con Majencio por el trono del Imperio Romano, oró al Señor Dios de los cristianos para que lo ayudara en su batalla. En respuesta a su oración, apareció un letrero en el cielo. Se vio una cruz luminosa con las palabras "POR ESTE SIGNO CONQUISTARAS" (en latín, "IN HOC SIGNO VINCES") inscrita en ella. Constantino ganó la batalla sobre Majencio.



In Hoc Signo Vinces

En deuda con Dios por su victoria en el puente De Milviano el 28 de octubre de 312, Constantino mandó que el signo del cristianismo se pusiera en las normas romanas y en los escudos de todos los soldados. **Luego, el 14 de septiembre del 326**, la madre del emperador Constantino, **Santa Elena, encontró en Jerusalén la Verdadera Cruz en la que Jesús fue crucificado.**

La leyenda de la historia del descubrimiento de la Cruz Verdadera es que, al visitar los lugares santos de Palestina, Santa Elena fue guiada al sitio de la Crucifixión por un judío envejecido que había heredado los conocimientos tradicionales en cuanto a su ubicación. Después de que el suelo había sido cavado a una profundidad considerable, se encontraron tres cruces, así como la super- inscripción colocada sobre la cabeza del Salvador sobre la Cruz, y los clavos con los que había sido crucificado. La Cruz del Señor se distinguió de las otras dos poniendo las cruces sobre un joven muerto que fue revivido por el toque de la tercera cruz.

Para conmemorar el hallazgo de la Santa Cruz, Constantino dedicó dos Iglesias al Calvario, "Anastasis" (Resurrección) y "Golgotha" (Crucifixión), ambas dentro de los recintos de **la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro**. A partir de esos días, **la fiesta de la "Exaltación de la Santa Cruz" se conmemoraba anualmente el 3 de mayo.**

En el 614, Cosroes II, el rey de Persia invadió Siria y Palestina, momento en el que se llevó muchos de los grandes tesoros de Jerusalén, incluida la reliquia de la Cruz Verdadera. En el 629, el emperador Heraclio de Constantinopla marchó a Persia y recuperó la Cruz Verdadera, viéndose a Heraclio traer piadosamente a Jerusalén la Santa Cruz mientras estaba vestido con un saco de penitencia y descalzo.

El 14 de septiembre, la Santa Cruz fue restaurada a su lugar en la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro en Jerusalén. Para conmemorar esta victoria, en el siglo VII d.C., la Iglesia de Roma adoptó la **"Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz" el 14 de septiembre.**

Hoy se puede visitar la Iglesia de la Basílica de la Santa Croce en Jerusalén (La Santa Cruz en Jerusalén), situada en Roma, en la que se consagra una parte considerable de la Santa Cruz junto con numerosas otras reliquias asociadas de la Pasión, incluida una gran parte del signo que había sido colocado en la Cruz diciendo "Jesús de Nazaret, rey de los judíos".



Es a partir de esta iglesia Basílica que se obtuvo la reliquia verdadera en nuestro templo de la Santa Cruz, Indiantown, Florida la cual llegó a las santas manos de la señora Yvonne Famel.
