

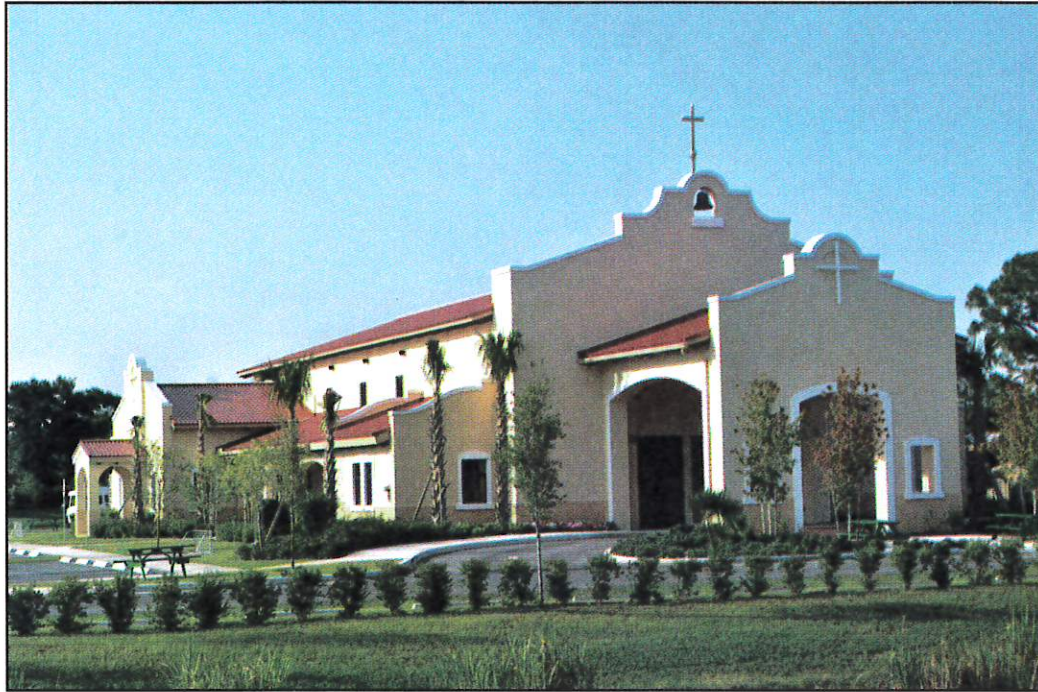

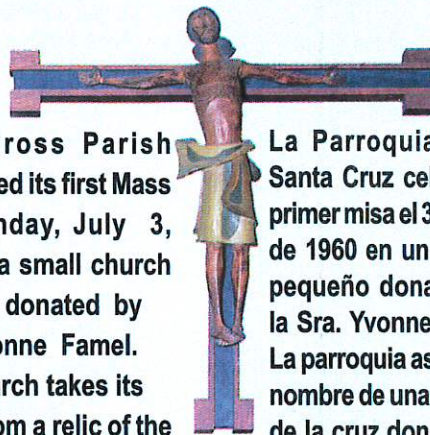

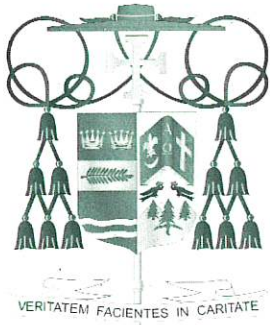

Dear Father Osorio:

As we come to the celebration of *Priesthood Sunday*, September 25, I wish to express to you my deep gratitude for your priestly ministry and for carrying it out in the dedicated manner that you do. You are a blessing to the people you serve, to your brother priests, and, in particular, to me. Each year I am inspired more and more by your commitment to your priesthood, and I continue to deepen my commitment to you as the primary responsibility of my episcopal ministry.

We have just entered the three-year period of *Eucharistic Revival* within our country as called for by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. *Priesthood Sunday* is a fitting time to reflect upon our unique role as the celebrant of the Eucharist and to understand it more deeply as essential to our identity as priests. We were ordained to celebrate the Eucharist and all of the many activities of our busy lives, including the celebration of the other sacraments, flow to and from the Eucharist. The Eucharist enables us to grow more intensely in our relationship to Christ, to the people we serve and to each other. It joins us together no matter what our ministry or personal situation may be.


In a recent apostolic letter of June 29, 2022, on the Eucharistic celebration, entitled *Desiderio desideravi*, Pope Francis has particular and insightful words for the priest as the celebrant of the Eucharist. He emphasizes how "The priest is continually formed by the action of the celebration," and that, "To preside at Eucharist is to be plunged into the furnace of God's love." Pope Francis reflects that, "The priest cannot recount the Last Supper to the Father without himself becoming a participant in it. He cannot say, 'Take this, all of you and eat of it, for this is my Body which will be given up for you,' and not live the same desire to offer his own body, his own life, for the people entrusted to him. This is what happens in the exercise of his ministry."

On this *Priesthood Sunday* may we, as brother priests, continue to be grateful for and humbled by the unique identity that is ours in celebrating the Eucharist. May it continue to be a source of unity with our people and with each other. I thank you for your formal remembrance of me each day in the Mass. I assure you of my special remembrance of you at Mass each day as a member of our presbyterate and as an individual.

I am blessed to be part of the presbyterate of the Diocese of Palm Beach. May the celebration of the Eucharist deepen our love and gratitude for each other in the unique role that we share.

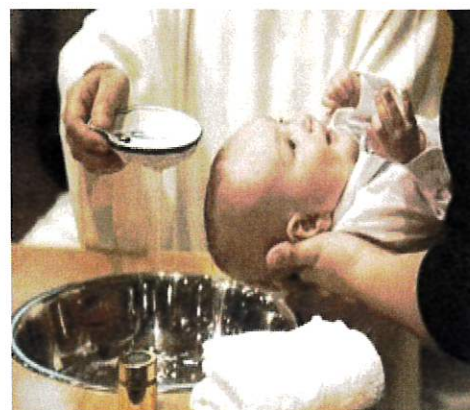


