

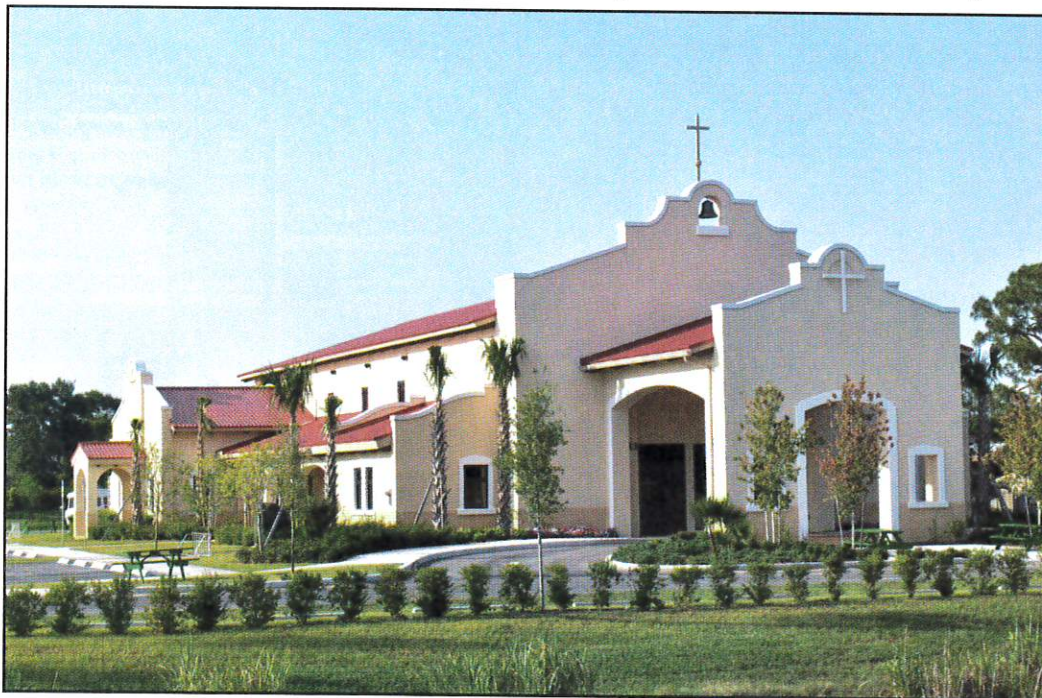

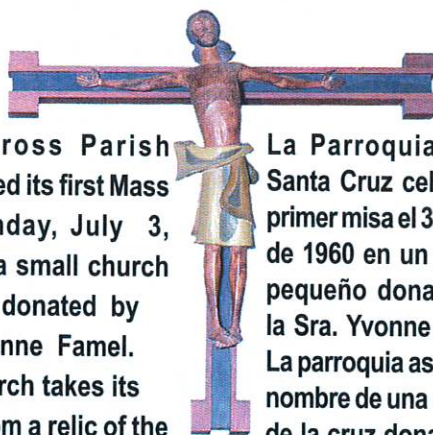

Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel. The Church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by

Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a

new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

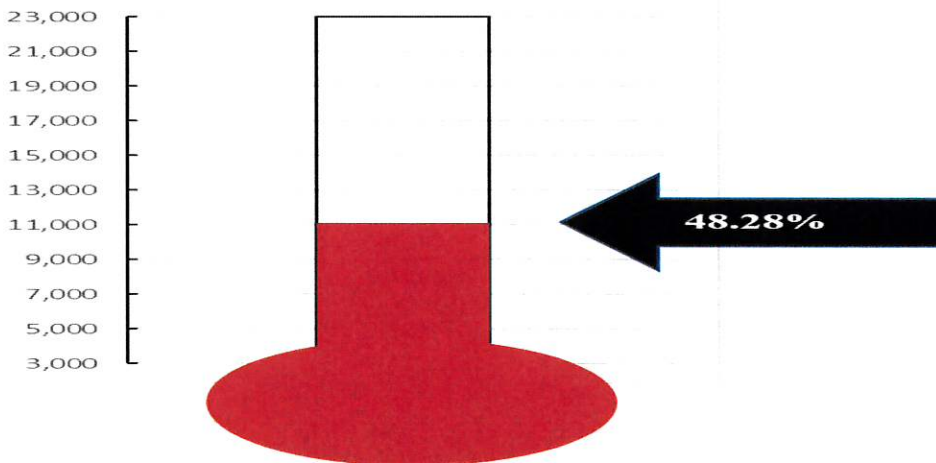

### MARATHON OF THE HOLY ROSARY FOR THE END OF THE PANDEMIC

Pope Francis will inaugurate on May 1st the marathon of praying the Rosary in which shrines of the world will participate to invoke the end of the pandemic. The whole Church is invited to join in this Marian prayer.

The prayer of the Rosary will be held every day of May 2021 at 6:00 p.m. (Rome time), 12:00 MT Eastern time, with a particular prayer intention and will be broadcast on Vatican channels.

This Saturday, May 1st, Pope Francis will pray before the Our Lady of Perpetual Help who is in the Gregorian Chapel of the Basilica of Saint Peter, and, on May 3 1st, the Holy Father will conclude this prayer marathon from the Vatican Gardens.

The theme of the marathon of the prayer of the Rosary is: "From the whole Church the prayer to God went up incessantly" (Acts 12: 5), a phrase chosen from the Book of Acts of the Apostles.

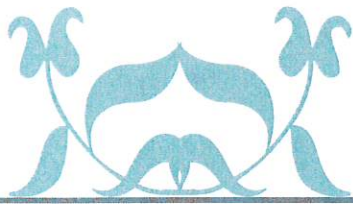

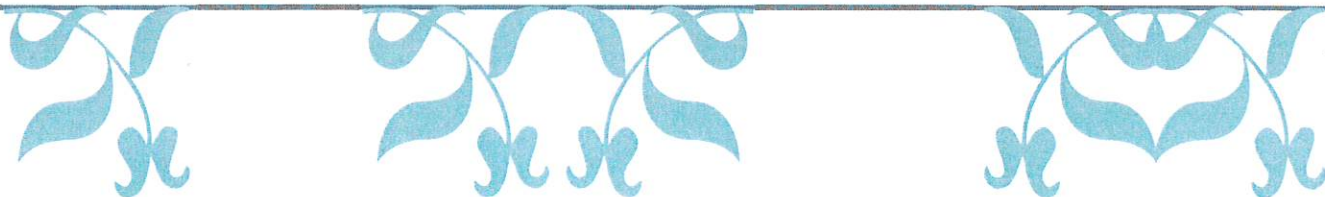

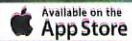
