

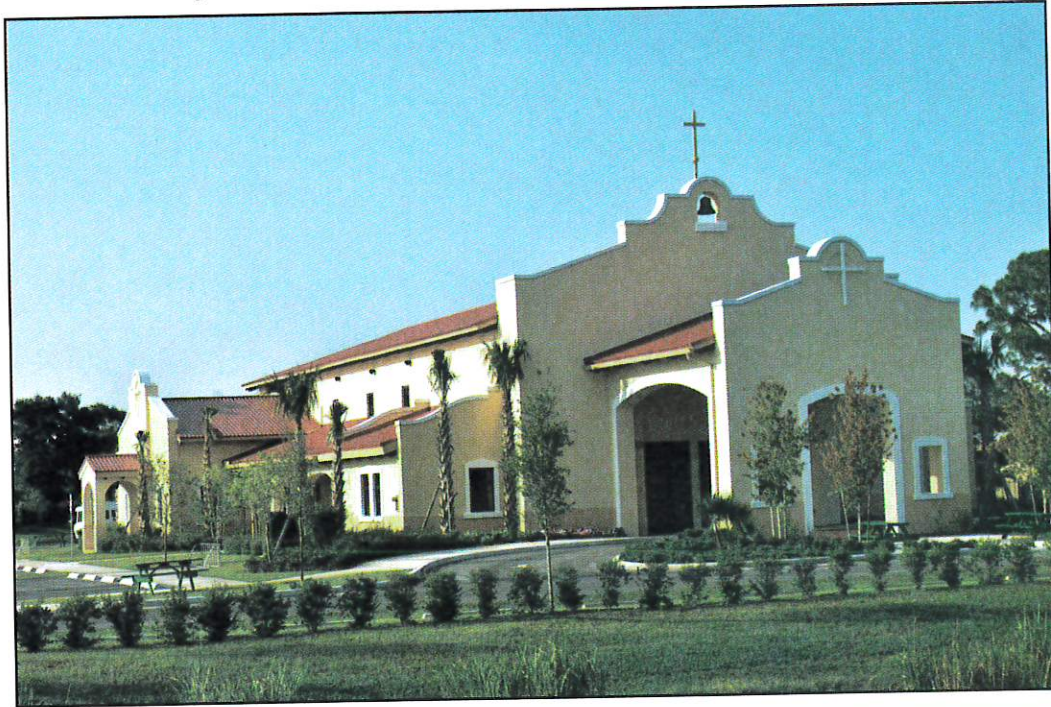

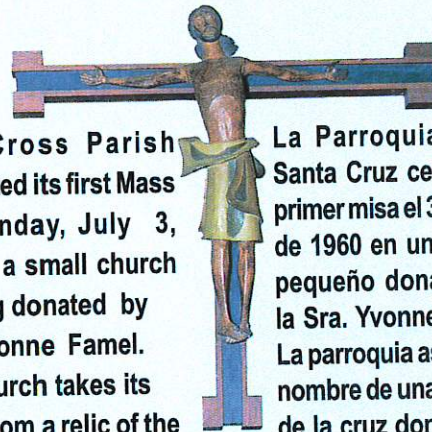

Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel.

The Church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by

Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a

new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

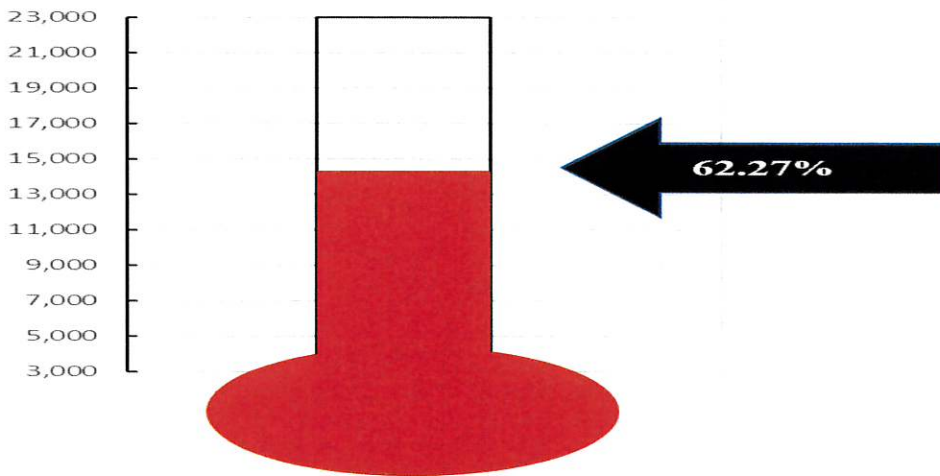

Fr. Francisco Osorio,

Our group, San Damiano Men's club of St. Lucie Catholic Church, was founded nine years ago to study our Catholic faith. One of our projects is to help the needy of Indiantown and Pahokee by supplying food, and clothing. Our collections of rice and beans over the last 9 years have been over 162,000 pounds or 81 tons of rice and beans and other food items. These collections are from the generosity of the people of our parish and the hard work of our volunteers in this men's group.

Our parishioners also are providing funds to us to help pay for additional rice and beans and other foods and to help us pay for truck rentals and fuel. We are buying over 1,500 pounds of food at Sam's club every other month thus adding to our parish collection. These parishioners know that all our efforts in these collections are going directly to Holy Cross and to St. Mary's of Pahokee, without any administration fees, thus every other month this donation is exactly what is given us.

We have had such a response, in the money given to us, that we have a small excess and we would like to give you a check for \$1,000 to be used for more perishable foods such as meats, poultry, eggs and fresh produce for the needy. Or, to perhaps use it to feed the "spiritual hungry" in your CCD children classes with supplies and books.

Please know that we will continue to keep the rice and bean program going, and with God's will and help, it will continue you grow and grow through the years ahead.

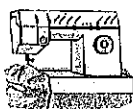

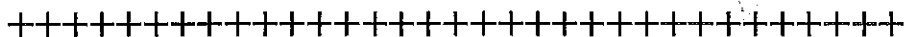
