

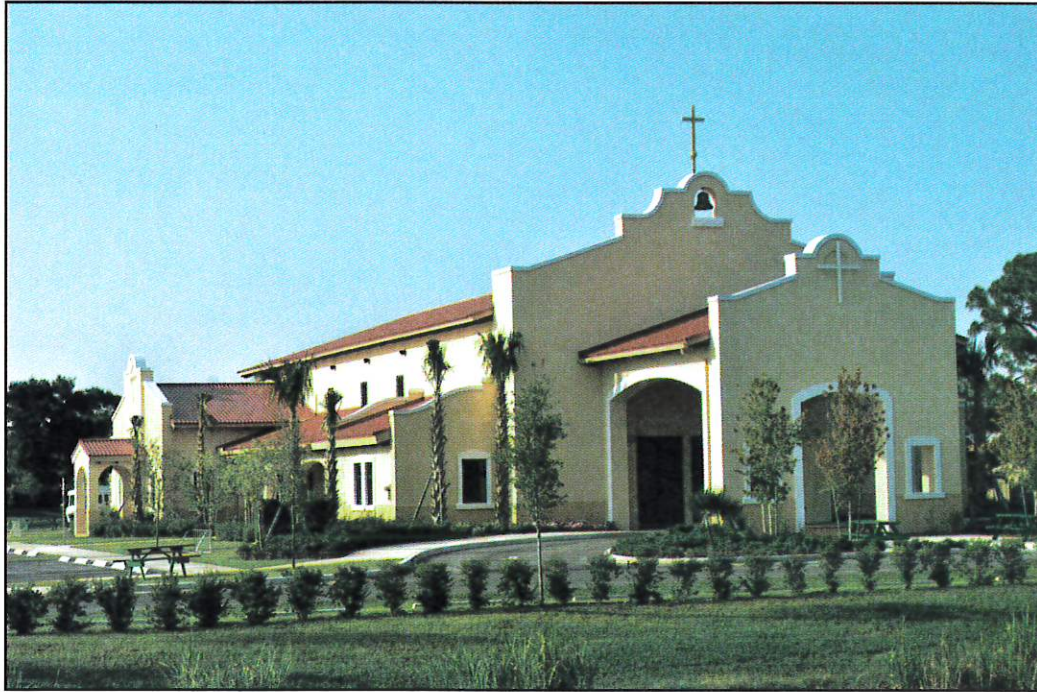

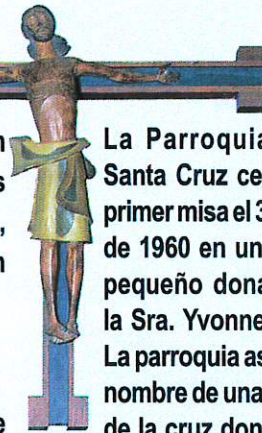

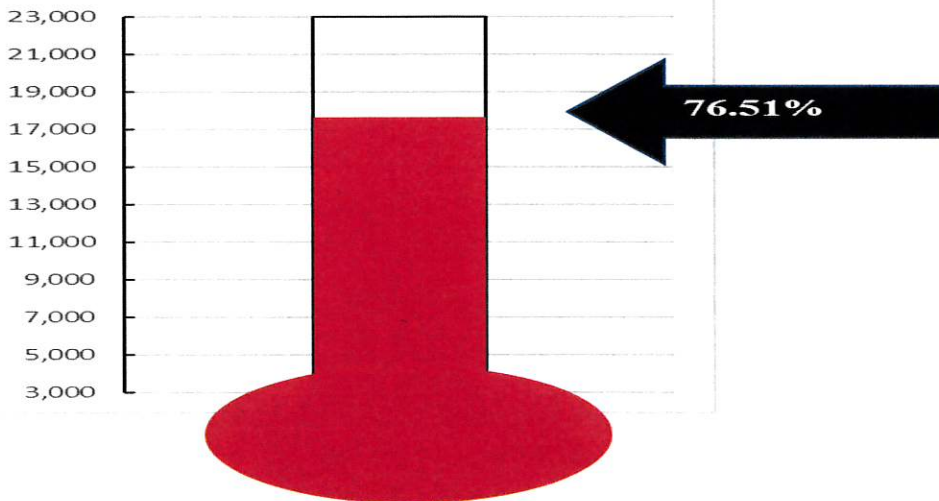

Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

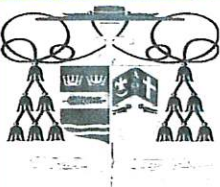

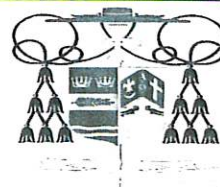

Synod on Synodality, Commission Participation, Mission

As you may know, Pope Francis officially opened the Synod on *Synodality, Commission Participation, Mission*, at the Vatican with the celebration of Mass this past Sunday, October 10. The Synod is taking place in three phases: the Diocesan phase, from October 2021 through April 2022, the Continental phase from September 2022 through March 2023, and the Ordinary Synod of Bishops, based on the consultation from the local and continental phases, at the Vatican in October 2023.

During the Diocesan phase, every Bishop will celebrate Mass at his Cathedral this coming weekend to open the Synod and invoke the Holy Spirit's guidance upon it. I will simply celebrate the Diocesan opening at Saint Ignatius Cathedral this weekend at the regularly scheduled Saturday evening Mass at 4:30 pm. The Mass will be live streamed.

Mrs. Cathy Loh, the Director of our Marriage, Family Life, Faith Formation and Youth Ministry Office, is the Director of the Synod for our Diocese. You will be hearing more from her in regard to the specifics for the consultation to take place, the questions involved, and the process to be followed. Our Diocesan website will be a main source of communication for the Synod. Next week, the website will carry my column giving more detailed information on the Synod process as well as a short video which I have prepared.

Please feel free to share any of this information with your parishioners this weekend and especially by asking for their prayers for the Synod. We pray for the guidance and wisdom of the Holy Spirit in this process and 100k forward to speaking and listening as widely as possible as Pope Francis has asked of us as a basis for the Synod and the life of the Church.

I am grateful for your assistance in this regard.

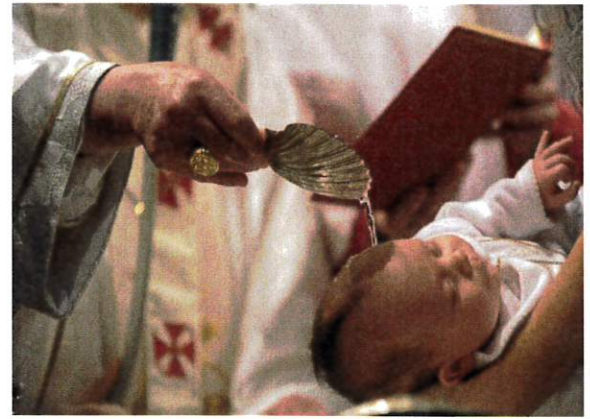

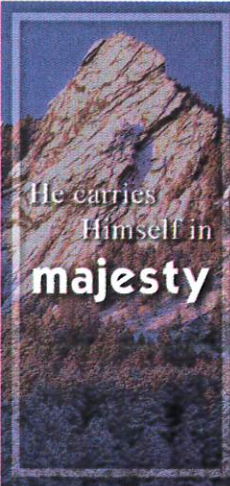

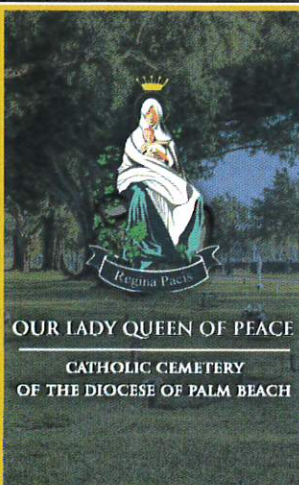
