

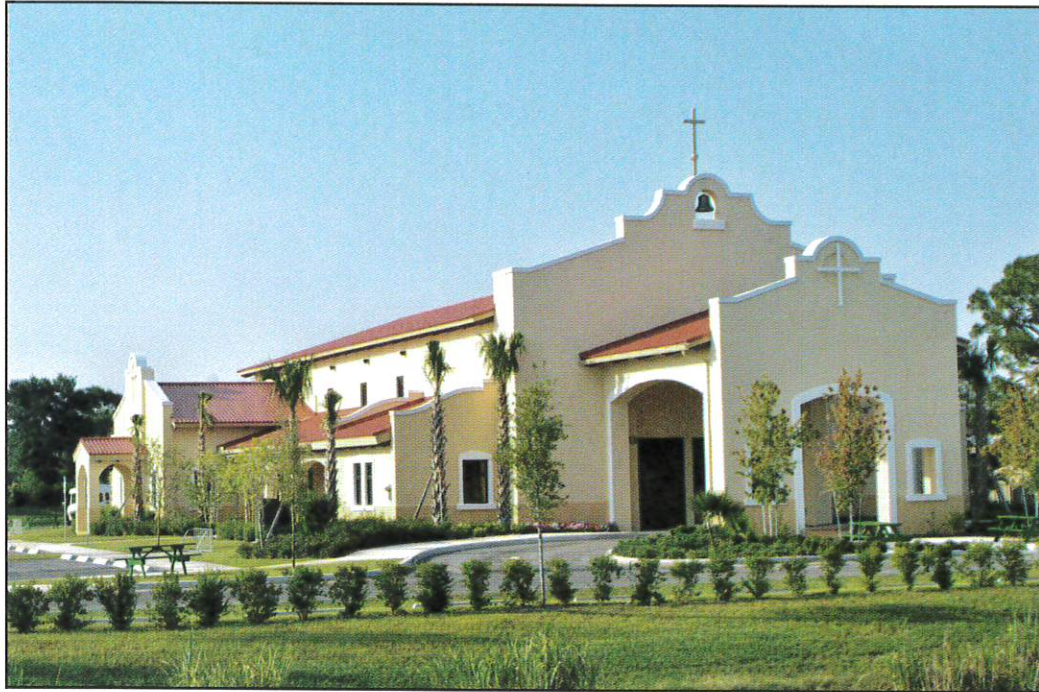

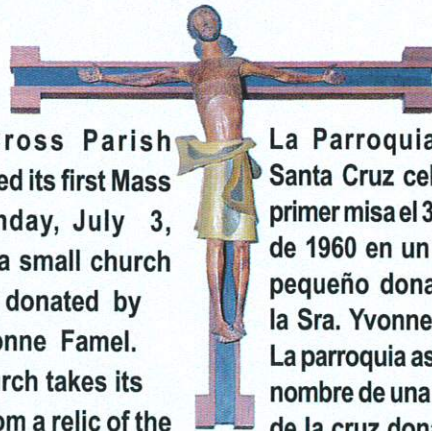

Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel. The Church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by

Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

Barbarito; siendo pastor el Rev. Nestor Rodriguez.

Hope Rural School Registration for the School Year 2019-2020

Registration for **new** as well as returning students, Pre-Kindergarten (3 and 4 year old's) through grade five takes place in **January**. This year registration will be done from **January 9-15, 2019, and January 22-23** at Hope Rural School.

New students seeking admission to Hope Rural School are required to have an entrance interview at a later date with appropriate school personnel as well as take a simple test. All new students to Hope Rural School **MUST** show proof of immunizations and have a current physical form on file in the school office, Students will not be allowed to attend school without these forms, as this is a requirement of the Florida Department of Health. Students must also show any report cards from their previous year of schooling.

PreK3 and PreK4 students must be 3 or 4 by September 1, 2019. and must be toilet trained to attend school.

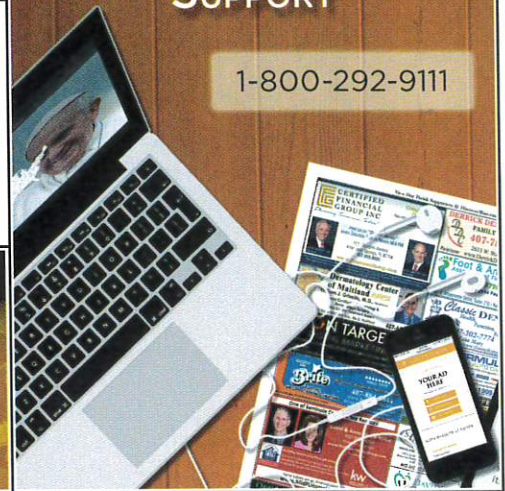
