

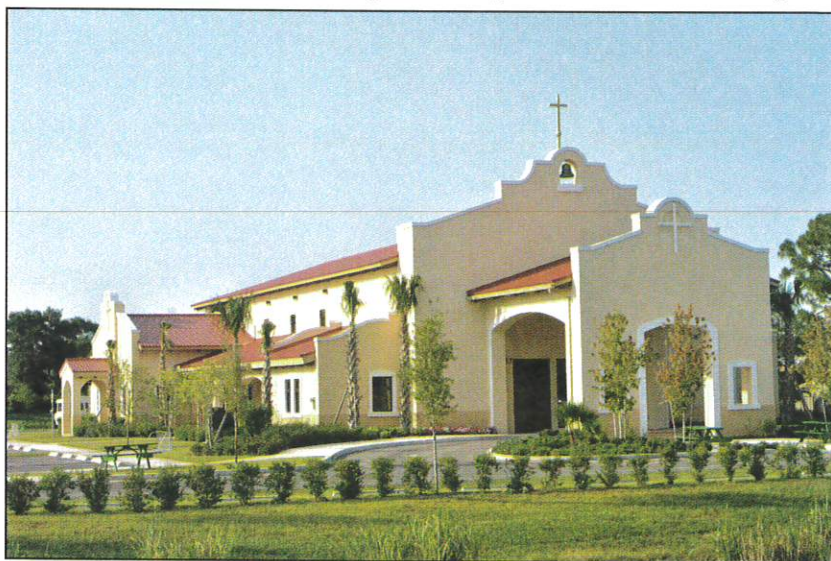

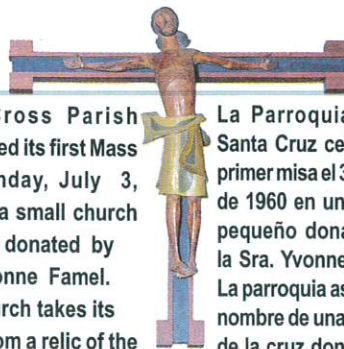

Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel.

The Church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

En el 2010 se terminó la contrucción del templo actual, y el 19 de septiembre del mismo año se hizo la dedicación en ocasión a la celebración del 50° aniversario de la parroquia, ceremonia presidida por el Obispo Gerald M. Barbarito; siendo pastor el Rev. Nestor Rodriguez.

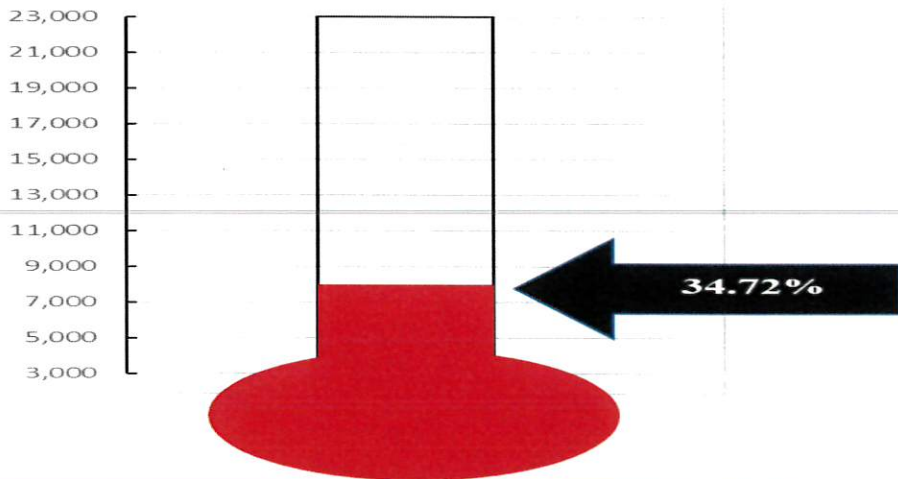

DIOCESE OF PALM BEACH CONTINUES TO MONITOR DEVELOPMENTS RELATED TO CORONAVIRUS

March 3, 2020

Although there are currently no known outbreaks or local infections in the area of the Diocese of Palm Beach, the diocese continues to closely monitor the developments related to coronavirus (COVID-19). Protocols for medical emergencies are reviewed and updated as necessary in compliance with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Florida Department of Health.

Please take precautionary measures to prevent the spread of respiratory infection. The CDC suggests such actions as avoid close contact with people who are sick; avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth; stay home when you are sick; cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash; clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe; and wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Precautions that parishes that can employ, at the pastor's discretion, include the temporary suspension of 1) the minor chalices used for the distribution of the Precious Blood, 2) the communal Sign of Peace (kissing or shaking of hands) and, 3) the greeting before Mass. Parishes may also empty the holy water fonts at the church doors and can encourage the use of anti-bacterial soap by the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion before and after distribution of the host. Also, parishioners may choose not to hold hands during the recitation/chanting of the Our Father. It is still left to the discretion of the communicant how they wish to receive the Host. As the distribution of Holy Communion involves contact with both the mouth and hands, any Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion who feels uncomfortable distributing Communion should be allowed to temporarily step down from ministry.

It is important to remember, if you are sick, you are encouraged to stay home. A Diocese of Palm Beach Televised Catholic Mass ministry is available for the community if you are not able to attend Mass. The Televised Catholic Mass can be found on CW34 at 10:30 a.m. every Sunday, on www.DiocesePB.org or on Facebook at @DiocesePB.

In addition, the Diocese of Palm Beach Office of Catholic Schools continues to monitor developments related to coronavirus and as always, upholds the safety of the Diocese of Palm Beach faculty, staff, students and families as a top priority. LA DIÓCESIS DE PALM BEACH CONTINÚA MONITOREANDO LOS DESARROLLOS RELACIONADOS CON EL CORONAVIRUS Marzo 3, 2020

Aunque actualmente no hay brotes conocidos o infecciones locales en el área de la Diócesis de Palm Beach, la diócesis continúa monitoreando de cerca los desarrollos relacionados con el coronavirus (COVID-19). Los protocolos para emergencias médicas se revisan y actualizan según sea necesario de conformidad con los Centros para el Control de Enfermedades (CDC) y el Departamento de Salud de Florida.

Tome las medidas de precaución para prevenir la propagación de la infección respiratoria. Los CDC sugieren acciones como evitar el contacto cercano con personas enfermas; evitar tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca; quédese en casa cuando esté enfermo; cubra su tos o estornudo con un pañuelo desechable, luego tírelo a la basura; limpie y desinfecte los objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia con un spray o toalla de limpieza doméstica; y lávese las manos a menudo con agua y jabón durante al menos 20 segundos.

Las precauciones que las parroquias pueden emplear, a discreción del párroco, incluyen la suspensión temporal de 1) los cálices utilizados para la distribución de la Preciosa Sangre, 2) el Signo comunal de la paz (besar o estrechar las manos) y, 3) saludo antes de la misa. Las parroquias también pueden vaciar las fuentes de agua bendita en la entrada de la iglesia y pueden fomentar el uso del jabón antibacterial por parte de los Ministros Extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión antes y después de la distribución de la comunión. Además, los feligreses pueden optar por no tomarse de las manos durante la recitación / canto del Padre Nuestro. Aún queda a discreción del comulgante cómo desea recibir la Comunión. Como la distribución de la Sagrada Comunión implica el contacto tanto con la boca como con las manos, a cualquier Ministro Extraordinario de la Sagrada Comunión que se sienta incómodo distribuyendo la Comunión se le debe permitir abandonar temporalmente el ministerio.

Es importante recordar que, si está enfermo, se le recomienda que se quede en casa. El Ministerio de la Misa Católica Televisada de la Diócesis de Palm Beach está disponible para la comunidad si no puede asistir a la Misa. La Misa Católica Televisada se puede encontrar en CW34 a las 10:30 am todos los domingos, en www.DiocesePBSchools.org o en Facebook en @DiocesePB.

La Diócesis de Palm Beach continuará abordando las preocupaciones relacionadas con el coronavirus, incluida la promoción de la conciencia e iniciando respuestas adicionales si es necesario.
