Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel. The church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

La Parroquia de la Santa Cruz celebró la primer misa el 3 de julio de 1960 en un templo pequeño donado por la Sra. Yvonne Famel. La parroquia asume su nombre de una reliquia de la cruz donada por la misma persona. En 1966 se contruyó un nuevo templo en la calle 150, dicho templo ahora funciona como centro pastoral. En el 2010 se terminó la construcción del templo actual, y el 19 de septiembre del mismo año se hizo la dedicación en ocasión a la celebración del 50° aniversario de la parroquia, ceremonia presidida por el Obispo Gerald M. Barbarito; siendo pastor el Rev. Nestor Rodriguez.

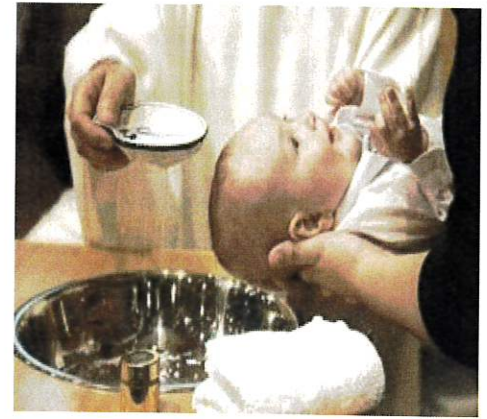

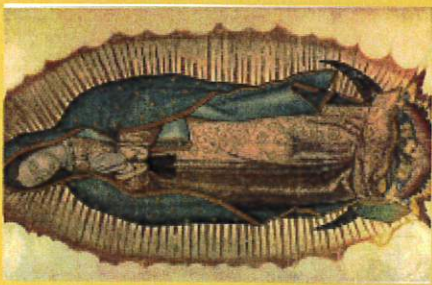

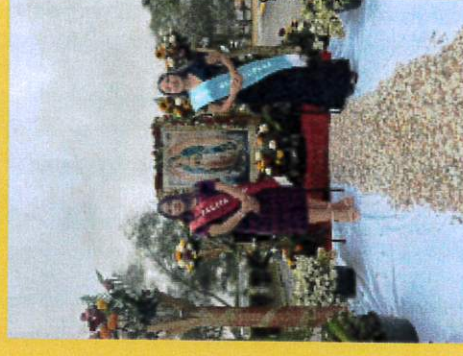

Good morning and Happy Thanksgiving.

The gospel for today's mass THE STORY OF THE TEN LEPERS is the one that is usually used for thanksgiving masses. I don't know if any of you have actually seen a person with leprosy but I have -up close and personal.

I was a missionary in Liberia West Africa for 8 years and there was a village with lepers not too far away. The priest from our mission went to visit the people every so often. Shortly after I had arrived there, he asked me to come with him for the visit. I have to say, I was terrified.

When we arrived, the priest jumped out of the van and the people came running to greet him with hugs and shouts of joy. I was frozen in my seat. The sight was difficult to behold. Many of the people were severely deformed and I was afraid I would catch the disease but I finally got the courage to get out of the van and allowed the people to greet me in the same way they did the priest.

In our gospel, Jesus is on his way to Jerusalem and ten lepers were at a distance yelling for Jesus to help them. These poor people had to stay away from their families and live in a separate place away from the rest of the community. So, you can just imagine how their lives were changed that day. The blessings of healing for them were beyond measure.

Jesus heals them and makes a point of saying only one came back to praise and thank him. As I reflected on this story and the meaning of gratitude, I thought of the nine people who once they were cured took their blessings for granted and went about just caring about themselves.

Only one came back and gave thanks. I don't think he only said the words " thank you." I think his life was changed forever and he took on an attitude of gratitude. Just think about it 1 out of 10 people were grateful for their blessings.

What is Jesus' idea of gratefulness, of thanks. What message did Jesus repeat over and over again , mentioned hundreds of times in the bible -LOVE love God and Love your neighbor.

That is the way Jesus asks us to live our lives. This is how Jesus wants us to say thank you. Using the many blessings we have -eyes to see the needs right in front of us- ears to listen and hear the cries of the poor, a mouth to speak out for justice- hands to carry others burdens and feet to walk for others needs.

People are starving to see the face of God.

Show them yours

Right here in our own community which does not have a lot of material things, we see this lived out –

- **Holy Cross Parishioners supports a mission in Guatemala**
- **Hope Rural School prepares boxes of joy filled with gifts for poor children all over the world**
- **For the past 5 years, the women at KinDoo Family Center have made clothes for children in Guatemala, Haiti, and Bolivia as well as fidget quilts for Martin County Hospitals and baby blankets and lap quilts for the needy here in Belle Glade.**
- **Many people from the community volunteer with organizations to help the poor**

No one is too young, too old, too poor or too busy to show the face of God to those who need it. Not just on Thanksgiving Day but 365 days a year. If we do this, I think we will hear God's voice saying to us - Thank You for being my body here on earth.

I'd like to close with a prayer from St Theresa of Avila. It is a daily reminder of our call to be the body of Christ.

We need **to stop**. Just stop.
Stop for a moment.
Before anybody
Says or does anything
That may hurt anyone else.

We need to **be silent**. Just silent.
Silent for a moment.
Before we forever lose
The blessing of songs

Notice for a moment.
Before the future slips away
Into ashes and dust of humility.

Stop, be silent, and notice.
In so many ways, we are the same.
Our differences are unique treasures.
We have, we are, a mosaic of gifts

Kind and gentle, innocent and trusting,
Like children and lambs,
Never judging or vengeful
Like the judging and vengeful.

And now, let us pray,
