Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel. The church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

En el 2010 se terminó la construcción del templo actual, y el 19 de septiembre del mismo año se hizo la dedicación en ocasión a la celebración del 50° aniversario de la parroquia, ceremonia presidida por el Obispo Gerald M. Barbarito; siendo pastor el Rev. Nestor Rodriguez.



In Memory of Sister Martha Rohde, O.P

Our dear Sister Martha Rohde, passed away as we all know. As a parish family, we would like to offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in his memory today.

A religious sister since 1966 and currently the principal of Hope Rural School in Indiantown, Sister Rohde has worked at schools every year except, when she was prioress of the St. Clara community in Sinsinawa. A native of Chicago, she has ministered in education in Illinois, Wisconsin, New Jersey, and Florida, including eight years in Indiantown with Dominican Sister Elizabeth Dunn, who serves as Hope Rural director.

As an independent Catholic school in the Diocese of Palm Beach, Hope Rural School relies on foundations, grants, benefactors, and state scholarship programs to meet its operational expenses. About 96 percent of its 135 students are first- or second-generation immigrants from Guatemala, Mexico, or Haiti.

It is with a heavy heart that I share the news of Sister Martha's passing away. Sister Martha has been a guiding light in our lives, exemplifying the profound love of God through her compassion, wisdom, and selfless service.

As we navigate this challenging time, let us come together as a community of faith to offer our thoughts and prayers for Sister Martha and her congregation, family, and Hope Rural School. Her impact on our lives is immeasurable, and her legacy of love will continue to inspire us.


