Holy Cross Parish celebrated its first Mass on Sunday, July 3, 1960 in a small church building donated by Mrs. Yvonne Famel. The church takes its name from a relic of the True Cross which was also donated by Mrs. Famel. In 1966 a new Church building was constructed and the parish moved to its current location on 150th Street. Holy Cross celebrated its 50th anniversary on September 19, 2010 at the dedication and blessing of our new church building.

La parroquia asume su nombre de una reliquia de la cruz donada por la misma persona. En 1966 se contruyó un nuevo templo en la calle 150, dicho templo ahora funciona como centro pastoral. En el 2010 se terminó la construcción del templo actual, y el 19 de septiembre del mismo año se hizo la dedicación en ocasión a la celebración del 50º aniversario de la parroquia, ceremonia presidida por el Obispo Gerald M. Barbarito; siendo pastor el Rev. Nestor Rodriguez.

Priesthood Recognition

Mark 10:35-45 tells the story of James and John seeking positions of honor alongside Jesus in His glory, but Jesus redirects them towards the true essence of discipleship: service and sacrifice. He reminds them that "whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant" (v. 43).

This passage resonates deeply as we honor the priesthood. In their vocation, priests follow the example of Christ, the servant-leader. They offer their lives in service to God and His people, embracing humility and love over earthly recognition. Priests labor in the vineyard, bringing the sacraments, the Word of God, and spiritual guidance to the faithful, often unseen and unheralded, yet profoundly impactful.

As we give thanks for the gift of the priesthood this month, let us pray for their continued strength and joy in serving God's people. May they be blessed abundantly, knowing that their true glory lies not in earthly rewards but in the eternal joy that comes from serving in the likeness of Christ. May we, too, be inspired by their example to serve one another with the same self-giving love.

Reconocimiento del sacerdocio

En **Marcos 10:35-45**, encontramos la historia de Santiago y Juan, quienes buscan posiciones de honor junto a Jesús en su gloria. Pero Jesús los redirige hacia la verdadera esencia del discipulado: el servicio y el sacrificio. Les recuerda que “el que quiera ser grande entre ustedes, debe ser su servidor” (v. 43).

Este pasaje resuena profundamente en este mes en el que honramos el sacerdocio. En su vocación, los sacerdotes siguen el ejemplo de Cristo, el siervo-líder. Ofrecen sus vidas al servicio de Dios y de Su pueblo, abrazando la humildad y el amor en lugar del reconocimiento terrenal. Los sacerdotes trabajan en la viña del Señor, trayendo los sacramentos, la Palabra de Dios y orientación espiritual a los fieles, muchas veces de manera discreta, pero con un impacto profundo.

Al dar gracias por el don del sacerdocio este mes, oremos para que los sacerdotes continúen sirviendo con fortaleza y alegría al pueblo de Dios. Que sean abundantemente bendecidos, sabiendo que su verdadera gloria no se encuentra en recompensas terrenales, sino en la alegría eterna que proviene de servir a semejanza de Cristo. Que nosotros también seamos inspirados por su ejemplo para servirnos unos a otros con el mismo amor abnegado.

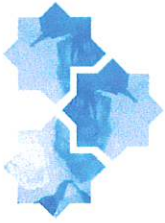

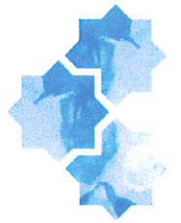


